

## Degering & Aitken win Irish Stableford by R.Martin 18-09-2011

On a good morning for golf at the Emerald Country Resort, the Emerald Golf Club held its annual Irish Stableford event on Saturday morning, where teams of two played normal stableford with the resulting teams score for a hole being the multiplication of the individual scores. Nearest to the pins were won by Brian McCoy on the 4<sup>th</sup>, Graeme Fergus on the 7<sup>th</sup>, Ross Martin on the 12<sup>th</sup>, Ken Hill on the 13<sup>th</sup> and Ian Scott the Pro-pin 18<sup>th</sup> winner. Next week is 2 man Ambrose stroke event and there should be many dealings to secure the inform players of Dean Aitken and Ian Scott as teammates for this event.
