Club Champs in huge tussle

With the big fluffies overhead dropping 20ml of rain overnight at Emerald Golf Club, conditions started as being assessed as trying, at best. When the big shiny parted the clouds great conditions prevailed. This was evidence by the fact that nearly half of all golfers bettered their handicaps.

This is making the club championship leader boards cluttered in the extreme. Aitken is joint leader in the handicap section along with Ken Sumsion (26) who played wonderfully consistent golf to close the gap on the field.

The day comp came down to a count back between Pund and Sumsion with Pund getting the nod after serious computations were completed as they both finished with nett 64. Pund won A

Grade while Sumsion won C Grade. In B Grade it was Town again winning and was also the grinner as it happened.

Dean Aitken had 65 as did his father Dave while Starick carded a 67 and Gareth Oldfield best of the rest on 68.

Nearest the pins went to Darryl White on the 4th, Leigh Morison the 7th (again!!!!) Phil A'Vard the 12th, Dennis Fuller the 13th and Dean Aitken rounded off a most successful day by winning the bullions for the pro pin on the 18th.
